

Kaikorai Primary School Walking School Bus

A Walking School Bus operates every morning from the top of Ross Street (just along from Roslyn Kindergarten) to Kaikorai Primary School.

A big “thank you” to all the children and adults who were part of the Walking School Bus during Term 1. Hopefully you’ll all continue to come along during Term 2 - and any new children that would like to join would be most welcome.



If you're thinking about taking advantage of the Walking School Bus, then here's some information that may be useful:

- The Walking School Bus is a great way to get your children to school - it's good exercise, it provides time for socialising and it cuts down the traffic congestion around the school.
- You can walk with your children if you want to or they can just walk with the group. There are 3 or 4 adults rostered on every day (to ensure safety) and often other parents also join us.
- The Walking School Bus leaves every morning at 8.20am.
- You can start at the beginning of the Walking School Bus (on the corner of Highgate and Belgrave Crescent at the top of Ross Street), or you can join the Walking School Bus along the way. We walk straight along Highgate to the Roslyn Village, cross Highgate there (via the 2 pedestrian crossings) and then continue along Highgate to the pedestrian crossing between Selkirk Street and Fifield Street, cross over at the crossing, go around the corner into Wright Street and then along to the school entrance.
